1 $\frac{1}{2}$ MILES. (Turf) (1.40¹) STAKES. Purse \$200,000 WOODFORD RESERVE BOURBON S. (GRADE III) FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$10,000 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start, with \$200,000 guarant eed, of which \$124,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$20,000 to third, \$10,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. In the event this race is taken off the turf, due to unsafe racing conditions, the horse that wins the 'off the turf' race will NOT receive an automatic qualifying position to enter the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded or group stakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed, Wednesday, September 24, 2008 with 30 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track. (Clear 74)

Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Apr), by Stormy Atlantic - Sultry Sal by Sultry Song. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by John Iracane(KY). BITTEL ROAD reserved along the inside, angled out once in the stretch and closed fast late to be up in time. DRIVING SNOW (GB) sluggish at the start, was outrun for a half, advanced four wide on the turn, wore down the leader to take command but missed. NINTH CLIENT set the pace off the inside and held on gamely. VAQUERO four wide early when close up, gained a short lead before a half, battled into the final furlong and held on gamely. JUST LIKE BISCUIT far back to the stretch, closed a late gap. HAR D BOY reserved early, raced in the three path on the second turn and lacked the needed closing bid. JACK SPRATT unhurried for a half, made a four wide middle move but could not sustain the bid. GIANT OAK within striking distance along the inside, lacked room through the stretch. GHOST FIVE forced the pace from the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. DYNAMIC FORCE reserved early along the inside, could not menace. APPALACHIAN TRAIL forwardly placed off the rail, gave way. ALBIN four wide early, stopped.
