1 1/8 MILES. (Turf) (1.401) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *BOURBON S. (GRADE III) FOR TWO YEAR OLDS*. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$5,000 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$500 to enter and an additional \$500 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded or group stakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over, 4 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Bourbon will be limited to twelve, with two also eligibles. In the event the race overfills the starters will be determined at that time by highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, September 28, 2011 with 37 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile and One-Sixteenth on the main track. (Cloudy 63)

ANIMAL SPIRITS settled between horses, angled out five wide entering the stretch, quickened once clear and was up in the final yards. COALPORT contended in hand, launched a bold bid four wide, forged a late lead but was unable to resist the winner. LUCKY CHAPPY (IRE) was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, advanced between horses leaving the second turn and into the stretch, got through the incident nearing the furlong marker unmolested and was making up ground. SPLENDIFEROUS stalked the pace three wide, inherited command with a furlong to run, but weakened during the drive and gave way. CHALYBEATE SPRINGS was unhurried into stride, circled five wide and improved position. CURFEW TOWER tracked the pace off of the inside inside, was collared between horses entering the stretch, steadied to avoid HERE COMES FRAZIER near the furlong marker and faded. GOLD MEGILLAH settled between horses, came three wide, was bumped and steadied in mid stretch and faltered thereafter. DOWNTOWN DRIGGS contended four wide, weakened entering the stretch, was bumped and carried out with a furlong to run and retreated. BURN THE MORTGAGE attended the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch, steadied hard to avoid the downed rival, served out bumping GOLD MEGILLAH and faded. MONASTIC settled saving ground, moved up between horses leaving the second turn, was bumped hard and forced wide in the drive and lost his best chance. SMART ELLIS was allowed to settle, ranged up along the inside on the second turn, shifted out between horses, was bumped and steadied and came up empty thereafter. HERE COMES FRAZIER opened clear to set the pace, dug in to meet the challengers entering the stretch, swerved in inside the three-sixteenths pole, hit the rail and unseated his jockey. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run, but following the review made no change to the order of finish.
