ORCHESTRATOR tracked the pace three deep, made her bid between horses through the second turn, forged a narrow lead entering the stretch and fought gamely to maintain the advantage. AGE OF HUMOR attended the pace in hand to the outside of ORCHESTRATOR, moved with that one with three furlongs to run, continued on well but was kept at bay following a prolonged drive. MIDWAY HOLIDAY was forwardly placed along the inside, angled out leaving the second turn, came five wide and was along for the show. CACTUS CADILLAC was allowed to settle, angled out to be clear, came seven wide and improved her position through the lane. ABSINTHE MINDED was unhurried into stride, angled in a bit on the backstretch, advanced between horses on the second turn, angled back to the outside entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. HELEN BELEN opened clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the second turn and gave way readily once headed. ALLEGATION broke a step slow, was bumped and clipped heels shortly after the start, angled in to save ground but failed to respond when called upon. LISA'S KITTEN broke outwardly bumping ALLEGATION at the start, tucked in to save ground but showed little thereafter. CASCADING pulled between horses early, settled off of the pace on the backstretch, but drifted out leaving the second turn and retreated.
