CHANNEL CAT moved to the lead entering the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace in the two path, entered the final turn under coaxing, responded well when asked for more spinning into the stretch, responded well under the whip in the drive, drifted out some approaching the sixteenth-pole and held gamely under strong urging, YA PRIMO (CHI) bumped with a rival at the start, was taken up into the first turn, saved ground while rated towards the front, was given his cue at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner with a clear hedge into the stretch, made an inside bid at the three-sixteenths, battled with the winner in the final furlong and missed while just able to get the place. ARKLOW dropped back early, settled on the inside, came under a drive in upper stretch, moved off the rail into the final furlong, gained between horses late and finished with good courage to just miss the place while narrowly able to get the show. CHANNEL MAKER broke in and bumped with a foe, was taken in hand early then rated just off the pace while inside to the two path, moved out inside the five-eighths pole, was asked in the three path on the final turn, came four wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong, made an outside bid outside the sixteenth-pole but just missed the trifecta. ZULU ALPHA was rated on the outside while racing two to three wide, came under urging in the four path on the final turn, chased into the final sixteenth. came between horses late and finished willingly. SADLER'S JOY dropped back at the start, was reserved towards the rear on the inside, waited while blocked from the three-sixteenths to the eighth-pole, found room and was asked shortly thereafter then also finished willingly.

OLYMPICO (FR) was reserved in the back half of the field while racing in the two path, came under urging near the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into the stretch, advanced into a reasonable striking position into the final furlong but flattened out. FOCUS GROUP went three wide on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, saved ground on the second turn, continued unhurried towards the back, rounded the final turn in the two path, was put to a drive in upper stretch, moved out outside the furlong marker and improved position. HIGHLAND SKY was reserved on the outside while racing two to three wide, came under urging while between horses on the final turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. ARGONNE was taken in hand in the two path on the first turn then rated while given cover, moved out from behind cover and angled four late on the second turn, pulled his way forward while tugging at the bit onto the backstretch, stalked outside from that point, was asked in the four path on the final turn, chased into the final furlong and weakened. CATCHO EN DIE (ARG) bumped with a foe at the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three wide on the second turn, raced outside down the backstretch, was roused near the seven-sixteenths, went three wide on the final turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten, RED KNIGHT settled on the outside while racing three wide. was roused near the five-sixteenths, came six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response.
