J. B.'S THUNDER set the pace off the inside, responded when asked for his best in upper stretch, drew off and stayed clear under steady urging. SANTIVA bore in at the start and steadied after bumping CONSERVATIVE VALUE, was outrun for five furlongs made a five wide run after six furlongs and closed well late. WILLCOX INN reserved inside, moved off the rail for the second turn, came out for the drive, angled back in with a sixteenth to go but hung. TYPHOON SLEW forwardly placed four wide, held on well to the stretch and tired. MAJOR GAIN within striking distance three wide, was bumped solidly near the half mile marker, recovered, made a four wide move after five furlongs but tired in the drive. ROUGH SAILING steadied on the first turn when in tight, recovered, made a good four wide move to the quarter mile marker but gave way in the drive. SILVER MEDALLION close up three wide, pulled his rider into traffic late on the backstretch, steadied and bumped MAJOR GAIN approaching the second turn and faded. MAYBESOMAYBENOT broke in the air, was outrun for a half, raced four wide on the second turn and could not threaten. LOU BRISSIE forwardly placed off the inside, faded. CONSERVATIVE VALUE roughed at the start, was outrun. BRICKYARD FAST lost his footing after the start, raced close up after recovering, held on well to the final quarter and faded.
