AWESOME TWIST raced in hand along the inside, advanced inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished gamely outside. REVERBERATE showed good speed while in hand, chased the pace from the outside, could not stay with the winner in upper stretch and tired in the final furlong. FUNNY CIDE raced close up early while in hand, was three wide around the turn and had no response when roused. GOOD REWARD was unhurried while outrun early, advanced inside on the turn and had no rally while on the rail in the stretch. WE CAN SEEK (CHI) was outrun early, put in a three wide run on the turn, swung wide into the stretch and tired in the drive.
