1 1/2 MILE. (2:24) STAKES. Purse \$400,000 Woodford Reserve Brooklyn Invitational S. (Grade II) AN INVITATIONAL FOR FOUR-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By invitation only with no nomination, entry or starting fees. The purse to be divided as follows \$220,000 to the winner, \$80,000 to second, \$48,000 to third, \$24,000 to fourth, \$12,000 to fifth and \$8,000 to sixth with the remaining \$8,000 divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One race at a mile or over in 2018-2019 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade Two race at a mile or over in 2018-19 allowed 4 lbs.; of a Grade Three race at a mile or over in 2018-19 allowed 6 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance at a mile or over in 2019 allowed 8 lbs. High weights preferred. Ties will be broken by total 2018-19 earnings. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Clear 80)

MARCONI retained the advantage after breaking forwardly placed, was coaxed along showing the way, with YOU'RE TO BLAME in accompaniment to the outside, saw REALM add himself to the pace picture approaching the conclusion of the backstretch, led the way on a slim advantage, hounded by a twosome two and three wide respectively from the top of the second bend until its end, was in the general area of the three-sixteenths marker when finally called upon for a response, offered one up readily, digging in with good determination to preserve the decision. ROCKETRY took up the chase primarily from the two path on each bend, was asked to pick it up angling to the outside for the drive home, wound up five wide by the three-sixteenths pole, charged down the center of the strip, making it to the wire in time to win the place photo. REALM underwent a three wide journey, disputed the pace as the widest of a threesome on the far turn, stepped into the lane, vied with vigour all the way down it, but fell short. CAMPAIGN sat in the two taking up the chase, was under a ride racing on turn two, narrowed in en route for the last significant slice of the pot. YOU'RE TO BLAME pressed the issue from path two, hand urged, went about the task from between rivals on the second turn, was the first of that group of three to see its pilot commit to a drive, doing so in the vicinity of the quarter pole, kept up a strong challenge until midstretch before weakening. SONNETEER firmly rated in the pocket until the quarter pole, went four wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response to make any real headway. BIBLICAL brushed at the start, settled towards the rear of the field, was three wide stepping onto the backstretch, travelled four wide under a strong drive on the far turn, failed to make up enough ground, reached the top of the lane and flattened out. WAR STORY hung out three wide on both turns, was through by the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the lane having been placed to a protective hold and was allowed to fade away.
