CONVEYOR'S ANGEL angled in and settled a bit off the rail, went up outside rivals on the backstretch, continued three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to proved narrowly best. SINGALONG (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and rallied willingly between foes to just miss. ATTIMA (GB) pulled early, stalked the pace off the rail, bid alongside a rival into the stretch, gained a short lead in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch, could not quite match the top pair late but held third. MEA DOMINA sent inside to the early lead, set the pace along the rail, fought back through the stretch but was outfinished late. GRANDE MELODY (IRE) three deep on the first turn, chased outside then between rivals leaving the backstretch, continued outside a foe on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAXXI ARTE (IRE) stalked between foes then fell back a bit into the second turn, came out into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. FLIP FLOP (FR) chased a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and also lacked the necessary late kick. QUEMAR (NZ) chased inside then a bit off the rail, continued between foes leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
