1 MILE 70 YARDS. (1.384) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 BUSANDA S. INNER DIRT FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2014 Kentucky Oaks, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Oaks published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The Busanda has also been selected as one of the races in the Kentucky Oaks Championship Series Prep Season. The winner of the Busanda will be awarded 10 points, the second place finisher 4 points, the third place finisher 2 points and the fourth place finisher 1 point. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 at a mile or over other than restricted stake allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming at a mile or over, 6 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, December 21, 2013 with 16 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement. (Clear 23)

FIERCE BOOTS hustled from the start to establish the pace, cut the pace along the inside in hand through comfortable fractions, came under coaxing as the pressure intensified at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner roused into the stretch, inched away under a drive and held sway to the wire. **FLIPCUP** in a bit tight down along the rail nearing the seven-eighths into the first turn, tracked inside in aim of the front, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch in behind the eventual winner, offered up a mild kick for the place honors. **FLEET OF GOLD** three to four wide just off the pace, got let out at the five-sixteenths, continued three wide for home, kept on mildly to garner the show. **KETEL TWIST** two to three wide in range of the front, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, bid mildly into upper stretch before weakening in the late stages. **ALPACA FINA** stumbled badly at the start getting off last, saved ground towards the rear, got asked midway on the turn and progressed by tired foes nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide into upper stretch and offered no further rally. **CAMILLE CLAUDEL** bumped at the start when **SPANISH GOLD** broke outwards, was in a bit tight between foes nearing the seven-eighths when **DEREK'S GIRL** shifted inwards, continued from the two path and had to briefly steady off heels near the three-quarter pole into the backside, settled three wide in mid pack, came under urging three furlongs from home, spun five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. **SPANISH GOLD** broke out at the start bumping **CAMILLE CLAUDEL**, settled three to four wide towards the rear, came under a ride at the three-eighths, angled five wide for home and was not persevered with in the final eighth. **DEREK'S GIRL** just off the pace in pursuit from just off the inside, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, retreated through the far turn and was eased at the head of the stretch.
