MIDNIGHT DISGUISE remained along the inside after lumbering out of the starting gate, had the pilot grab hold as another was working her way along the inside, tipped out into path in time for the beginning of the run around the clubhouse bend, was maneuvered out into path four coming up to the conclusion of the backstretch, launched itself into a strong contending position with a sustained run, got called upon challenging in earnest heading into the stretch, out-dueled the runner up to claim the top, then kicked clear, kept to the task at hand.

OLDFASHIONED STYLE showed the way being rated along towards the inside, felt the winner's presence approaching the quarter pole, was stationed in the two path settling in at the head of the stretch, got reeled in midstretch after putting up a fight, fell back steadily afterwards but held on sufficiently to salvage second. HAIL tracked the leader from the inside, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths marker, proved no match. WEALTH EFFECT unhurried in the two path during the initial stages, got roused leaving the midway point on the far turn, fanned out into path six nearing the three-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response. INCLEVELAND strung out three to two wide on the turn, gave way. TAKE CHARGE TINA set up in the two path after an alert getaway, prompted the pace for a half and retreated. DUE TO TIMER MALFUNCTION, FRACTIONS ARE UNAVAILABLE. THIS RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
