ESPRESSO SHOT bumped at the start by OXY LADY breaking inwards and in turn bumped UJJAYI, raced five then four wide in pursuit from near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths advancing into striking range swinging five to six wide into upper stretch, rallied to stack outside a trio and was bumped inside the three-sixteenths by ORRA MOOR due to pressure from the coming outwards PLEASE FLATTER ME, took over command a sixteenth from home and inched away to the finish kept busy to the end. OXY LADY broke in at the start bumping the aforementioned foe into UJJAYI before being corrected, settled two to three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch, had an open seam between foes ORRA MOOR and ESPRESSO SHOT directly ahead and began to rally on through when forced to check inside the three-sixteenths when bumped and put in tight by ORRA MOOR due to pressure from PLEASE FLATTER ME coming out under a near sided stick, lost about a length and a half of momentum as a result, got placed to a light drive and came again to secure the place honors in the last jumps to the wire showing good courage, then was subsequently vanned off after the finish. ORRA MOOR prompted the pace five then four wide to the outside of a pair under coaxing from the half mile pole, swung four wide into upper stretch heads apart for command, got bumped inside the three-sixteenths as PLEASE FLATTER ME came out under a near sided stick and in turn forced OXY LADY to check off her heels when tightening the lane between her and ESPRESSO SHOT brushing that rival, dug in under a drive and fought on with a trio to be along for the show honors in a blanket finish. PLEASE FLATTER ME broke inwards brushing the near side stall at the start, raced forwardly placed four then three wide prompting the leader into the turn in tandem with the aforementioned foe to her outside, took over narrow command just inside the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, dug in loosely between foes shaking off FILLY JOEL to her inside when confronted outside by a direct pair and a third challenger nearly between them, came out under a near sided stick bumping ORRA MOOR into ESPRESSO SHOT and closing the seam between those foes forcing OXY LADY to check off their heels when also bumped lightly, dug in knocking clinging to the front until headed a sixteenth from home, then got outfinished in the late stages while clear for the last major share. FILLY JOEL prompted the pace three then two wide taking narrow command when placed to coaxing three furlongs from home, got headed herself inside the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home with a trio latched on to the outside, steadily got shaken off nearing the eighth pole and weakened in the final furlong. ENLIVEN four then three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and weakened. DOVEY LOVEY chased six then five wide under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, angled seven to eight wide into upper stretch and tired. EXCESS CAPACITY established the front and showed the way lightly coaxed along just off the inside under pressure from a trio, tucked inside half a mile out, vielded the front three furlongs from home, got ridden along fading through the latter portion of the turn, swung two to three wide at the quarter pole and faltered. UJJAYI bumped at the start by ESPRESSO SHOT due to pressure from the breaking inwards OXY LADY, chased along the inside from just off the pace coming under coaxing with nine-sixteenths to go, faded through the turn to the tail of the field, went three wide into upper stretch and tired. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on PLEASE FLATTER ME in the stretch run as well as an objection lodged by the trainer of OXY LADY against ESPRESSO SHOT
