DISTANT VICTORY broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside, went outside a rival on the backstretch and three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch, then inched away. RUSHEN HEAT took the early lead, set the pace inside, inched away again on the second turn and held on gamely to deep stretch and saved the place. SPORTS EDITION chased inside, moved up on the second turn, came a bit off the rail in late stretch and just missed second. POWEROFVOODOO pulled early, chased inside, went outside a rival on the second turn, continued between horses leaving that turn and into the stretch and was outfinished. CHATEAU SUISSE stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the runner-up on the backstretch, tracked that one again on the second turn, was between horses in midstretch, drifted in some and weakened in the final furlong. WARRENS HIGHROLLER chased inside or a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, dropped back between foes on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
