LUCKY PRIMO chased outside, moved up four wide on the second turn, took the lead three deep into the stretch, kicked clear past the eighth pole, drifted in under urging and proved best. TRIUMPHANT FLIGHT dueled between horses or outside a rival, continued between foes into the stretch, fought back in midstretch and held second. ESCALON stalked inside, came out for room into the stretch, angled back in and just saved the show. J P JAMMER chased four wide on the first turn and outside rivals on the backstretch, went four wide again on the second turn and into the stretch and just missed third. STAR REDEEMER unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, swung three deep into the stretch and split rivals on the line. DANNY Q stalked a bit off the rail then between horses on the second turn and lacked the needed response. LEYVA MAN chased between foes then outside, came four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. CONTROL SEEKER also chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. MIGUEL'S MASCOT three deep on the first turn, settled between horses, continued just off the rail in the stretch, was in a bit tight in deep stretch and lacked a rally. BABS MOOSSA chased between foes then inside, steadied in tight a bit off the rail in deep stretch and did not rally. MENSA HEAT pulled his way along inside, bid along the rail on the backstretch, dueled for the lead and weakened in the stretch, then steadied when a bit crowded late. AQUICKSTING dueled three deep, stalked on the second turn and also weakened. BRUIN BENCH pulled his way along off the rail then outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and failed to menace.
