SAUCEY EVENING a bit slow to begin, settled just off the rail, went up three deep into the second turn then outside a rival, continued off the inside into the stretch, came out in the drive and rallied under urging to gain the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. TEN CHURROS sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and held second. SPANISH ICE five wide into the first turn, angled in and stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, bid alongside the runner-up leaving that turn and into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong but held third. ATKA chased three deep, came four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at the show. SALTY SARAH pulled her way along to chase between horses then a bit off the rail, split rivals on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AMINA steadied in tight into the first turn, chased inside then came off the rail leaving the backstretch, went outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. TAMMY'S LUCK chased between horses then angled in on the first turn, split horses on the second turn, regained the inside and lacked a rally. TRASH MASTER chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the needed response. LISTISIMO pulled between horses then stalked off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. ROCKSTER stalked inside, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
