SWIFT WINDS settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival, came out in midstretch and rallied under some urging to get up three deep in the late stages. BOLD CHIEFTAIN stalked the pace a bit off the rail then between horses on the second turn, came out into the stretch and rallied between foes in deep stretch. LIBERIAN FREIGHTER pulled his way along inside to duel for the lead then stalked on the backstretch, re-bid outside a foe on the second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead, fought back toward the inside in deep stretch and held third. PASS THE HEAT chased inside, came out into the stretch and continued willingly but was edged for the show. UNUSUAL SUSPECT settled outside a rival then inside, saved ground to the stretch, came out a bit in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. COMOROS had speed outside a rival then kicked clear and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail on the second turn and in the stretch and weakened late. EPIC POWER chased outside a rival then three deep into and on the second turn, could not summon the necessary response in the stretch.
