GUTS chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. TRATO stalked inside, came out on the second turn and bid three deep, continued between horses through a stiff drive and went willingly to the wire. PEACHY CANYON came out crossing the main track, angled in and set a pressured pace inside, dueled on the second turn, fought back along the rail in the stretch and continued gamely to the end. LOCKFORD forced out crossing the main track, stalked off the rail, bid outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn and between horses leaving that turn and through the stretch and weakened late. TIZMET chased outside a rival, angled in on the second turn and did not rally. CARONA TIME settled off the rail then inside, saved ground off the pace, came out some in the stretch and failed to menace. EXPRESS RAIL saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the backstretch, was pulled up and vanned off. Rail on hill at zero.
