By subscription of \$200 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$2,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,000 to start - with \$200,000 guaranteed. The Owner of the winner to receive \$120,000, \$40,000 to second, \$22,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$50,000 at a mile or over, 5 lbs.; \$35,000 or non-winners of two races other than Maiden, Claiming or Starter at a mile or over, 7 lbs. Graded placed horses at equal weights preferred. Graded stakes winners preferred. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Closed Saturday, September 30, 2006 with (14) nominations. Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Feb), by Atticus - Uhavethebeat by Unbridled. Trainer Wolfson D. Martin. Bred by Live Oak Stud(KY). CAN'T BEAT IT rated off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn, rallied to take over entering the stretch and drew away under urging. CROTON ROAD reserved off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn, then closed to be up for the place while no match with the winner. ELIZABUL bumped between rivals at the start, tracked the pace, rallied to gain the lead briefly on the far turn, then couldn't stay with his entymate and was outfinished for the place. MURCH unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. FANCY SILVER well placed while saving ground, was steadied in behind JET PROPULSION on the far turn and had no response when clear. WORLD BATTLE allowed to settle after hitting the gate at the start, failed to menace. FAMOUS FROLIC ducked in at the start causing his rider to lose his left iron briefly and never threatened. DESERT WHEAT bumped with ELIZABUL at the start and was not a factor. GIN RUMMY KING tired from good position. HOW'S YOUR HALO sprinted to a clear lead along the hedge, made the pace to midway of the far turn, then faltered. JET PROPULSION bumped with ELIZABUL at the start, chased the pacesetter along the hedge into the far turn and faded.
