The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight Three-Year-Olds 119 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 race at a mile or over in 2008, allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Grade II race at a mile or over in 2008 or a Grade 1 race at a mile or over in 2007, allowed 5 lbs.; Of a Grade III race at a mile or over in 2008 or a Grade II race at a mile or over in 2007, allowed 7 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 at a mile or over in 2008 or a Grade III race at a mile or over in 2007, allowed 9 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2008 or a Sweepstakes of \$75,000 at a mile or over in 2007, allowed 11 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance.) (Note: Grades as recognized by the International Cataloguing Standards Committee.) Final entries to be made through the entry box no later than 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, September 4, 2008. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$6,000, which includes the entry fee. \*Plus up to \$22,950 Ontario Sired/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. J'RAY raced off the pace, closed three-deep late turn, gained steadily and took command a sixteenth out under a drive. CALLWOOD DANCER (IRE), in range two-wide, chased into the stretch, bid midstretch and drew clear but failed failed to stave off the winner with a sixteenth to run. FOREVER TOGETHER raced off the pace along the rail, was hustled late turn, launched a game stretch drive but evened out in the late stages. SEALY HILL raced midpack, closed four-wide on the the turn, came five-wide into the stretch, lodged her bid at the 3/16th pole but was no match and evened out. SOCIAL QUEEN settled early, gained gradually two-deep late turn, was all out in the stretch but failed to menace. QUIET JUNGLE stalked along the rail, forced the pace from midturn, took command at the top of the stretch, led well into the stretch but gave way approaching the furlong marker. STROKE THE TIGER sprinted clear quickly, set the pace, drifted out a bit leaving the turn and tired. TELL IT AS IT IS raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn, angled out upper stretch, launched her rally but needed more response. CIAO raced midpack four-wide and lacked a rally. THE NIAGARA QUEEN, in range, forced the pace three-wide on the turn, was squeezed back a bit upper stretch and tired. DANZON stalked the pace, came three-wide late turn then tired in the stretch.
