

# TENTH RACE Gulfstream Park February 21st, 2015

1 MILE. (Turf) (1:34<sup>1</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Canadian Turf S.FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes at a mile or over on the turf since October 1, allowed 2 lbs.; of a graded stakes at a mile or over on the turf since June 1 allowed 4lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over since July 1, 6 lbs. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest career earnings. In the event this stakes is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 7, 2015 with 41 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 84 feet). (Clear 72)

LONG ON VALUE settled off the leaders early, was bumped nearing the three-eighths marker, moved outside through the second turn, reached the fore inside the quarter and steadily drew clear. GRAND TITO was fractious at the gate, raced unhurried early, moved outside through the second turn, angled out further into the stretch and finished with good energy to gain the place. ARIPEKA raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and finished with a late rally. JACK MILTON was off a step slow then allowed to settle, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with a late bid. EXCAPER was reserved just off the leaders from the inside, stayed inside for the drive and finished willingly. MR. ONLINE was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and found his best stride late. SKY BLAZER lacked early foot, raced extremely wide through the second turn and did not menace. GUYS REWARD showed no early speed, saved ground through the second turn and finished with some late run. SILVER FREAK set a pressured pace from the inside for six furlongs and gave way. SMOOTH DADDY pressed the pace of SILVER FREAK from the outside and also gave way after going three-quarters. MUTIN (FR) was pinched back at the start, raced wide through the second turn and did not offer a bid. BEST PLAN YET settled off the leaders early, was bumped nearing the three-eighths pole, moved far wide through the second turn and gradually weakened. ADIRONDACK KING chased the leaders from the outside, was bumped nearing the three-eighths marker and weakened in the drive.
