1 MILE. (Turf) (1:31²) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Canadian Turf S. (Grade III) FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Sunday, February 17. \$1,500 to enter. \$150,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes at a mile or over on turf since September 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes on turf since September 1, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. In the event this race is taken off turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review of the Graded Stakes Committee. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 96 feet). (Clear 81)

KRAMPUS was away in good order and forwardly positioned through first turn, settled nicely racing in tracking mode off the clear pacesetter, let out notch leaving backstretch and steadily progressed to challenge SIEM RIEP for lead at quarter pole, turned for home with slight edge, dug in and got by SIEM RIEP then faced with challenge of BREAKING THE RULES, kept on gamely deep stretch and prevailed. BREAKING THE RULES off to good start then raced three wide into first turn, settled off the clear pacesetter through early stages, made outside bid racing in tandem with KRAMPUS and moved up at quarter pole, determined in pursuit for late lead, game kick to wire and just missed. HOLIDAY STONE raced couple paths off inside running through the backstretch, sat in good position just off top trio at quarter pole, angled out turning for home then lugged in behind BREAKING THE RULES, straightened out under left handed drive and lasted for share. HEMBREE raced off the early pace, hustled up two to three wide in final turn then came under left handed urging and shifted to outside position upper stretch, continued with response gaining on show. COWBOY CULTURE was unhurried racing in the back, picked up pace along inside in far turn then angled out upper stretch, continued with response and finished strides away from gaining show. SIEM RIEP led the way in the first turn, set the pace and widened to clear advantage on top, challenged by duo at the quarter pole, fought back upper stretch then had no kick left in reserve and gave way.
