Scatuorchio(KY) CAPTAIN WEBB assumed a forward position soon after the start, muscled out a complying MAGICAL MOMENT to take over the three

path early down the backstretch, continued to bide time stalking the front runners until the seven-sixteenths pole, had the rider release a firm hold on the reins and cruised up to the pacesetter and his main pursuer, turned for home on nearly even terms, the widest of a threesome, was

asked for a response and worked his way to the front by the three-sixteenths pole, edged away in the final furlong under good handling.

DADDY NOSE BEST three wide leaving the homestretch soon worked out a tuck into the two path a few strides into the run around the

opening bend, sat under a good hold, reserved in midpack and between rivals for much of the way, was within striking position approaching the

quarter pole, when forced to steady off a rival's heels, found room and swung four wide into upper stretch, responded positively once given his

cue, gained ground readily during the ensuing furlong, tipped outward an additional path near midstretch for better racing clearance and came home with good energy belatedly to grab second. SATURDAY CLASSIC unhurried during the initial stages, ranged up into contention three wide on the far turn, paused late on that bend, spun three to four wide into the stretch and was immediately set down, finished willingly down the center of the course to grab the show. HONOR CALL away well, made the front well before reaching the first turn, was taken over to the inside, set the splits, well rated, and with an equally rated MASTER ACHIEVEMENT accompanying him from the outside, had the rider still

attempt to keep something in reserve, as first the aforementioned rival and then the eventual winner, turned up the pressure leaving midpoint

on the far turn, appeared to be possession of the slimmest of edges leading a tightly-bunched trio into the stretch, was asked for a response,

offered some resistance before relinquishing, remained a prominent factor until the furlong marker, steadily weakened thereafter. TIZ A straightaway approach leading to the first turn, the last being FURMAN BISHER, to tuck into the two path, pressed the pacesetter from the

HOMERUN patiently rode the rail, was forced to steady when caught behind traffic nearing the quarter pole, angled gradually to be four wide by the three-sixteenths pole, rallied mildly thereafter. MASTER ACHIEVEMENT off to a good beginning, made his way past rivals during the outside, with both horses being rated along, moved up to look the leader in the eye about the three-eighths pole, continued to vie for the lead, now between rivals, until upper stretch before backing away. MAGICAL MOMENT was three wide entering the backstretch, lost that position to

the top one soon afterwards, raced four wide on the far turn, before availing of an opening to settle inward and be only two wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, had no stretch offering to render. QUIET DANGER lunged at the break, making light contact with the right side of the gate to get off slowly, sputtered a bit entering the first turn three wide, continued to lag behind throughout the initial stages, was asked for a response leaving the half mile pole, failed to reach a contending position. COLBERT angled sharply towards the rail leaving the starting gate, sat in midpack, had no rally. FURMAN BISHER pulled up on the first turn, was subsequently vanned off.
