SABELLINA, within easy striking distance always and four or five wide, gained the advantage nearing the final furlong, then was fully extended the remainder earn the nod over SILCA'S SISTER (GB) on the wire. SILCA'S SISTER (GB) gained the advantage early, moved in two or three wide, was headed on the backstretch briefly by CAROLINA SKY, regained the edge, showed the way into the upper stretch, lost the lead to SABELLINA, was coming again at the finish but lost on the nod. ROYAL COPENHAGEN (FR), unhurried early while racing four or five wide, was between horses five wide for the final furlong but gained only slightly. RICH IN SPIRIT, never far back while following the leaders five wide, failed to offer a closing account. MORE THAN PROMISED, well placed throughout and between rivals three or four wide, loomed prominently for the last eighth and came up empty. DASH OF HUMOR broke to the inside, was steadied and taken in hand, raced well off the pace, came out seven or eight wide leaving the second turn and improved position. STORMINA, nicely position two or three wide into the final furlong, came up empty. BLACK JAVA, reserved early along the inside, worked her way out eight or nine wide for the stretch run and lacked a serious bid. AMORAMA (FR), never far back and racing near the inside, flattened out in the drive. BEAUTIFUL BETS raced in contention for nearly six furlongs while three or four wide and weakened. CAROLINA SKY angled in early to force the pace four wide, briefly headed front-running SILCA'S SISTER upon going a half, continued forwardly for six furlongs and weakened.
