1 1/2 MILES. (Turf) (1.461) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 *CARDINAL H. (GRADE III) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$100 or by supplementary nomination of \$5,000 each by 12:00 noon (EST) Friday, November 7, 2008. \$500 to pass the entry box; \$500 additional to start, with \$100,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Saturday, November 8, 2008. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. (If this race is taken off the turf it will be downgraded one grade level for this running only in accordance with American Graded Stakes Committee policy). Closed Saturday, November 1, 2008 with 34 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Eighth mile.). (Rainy 45)

Chestnut Filly, (Feb), by Pleasant Tap - Catnip by Flying Paster. Trainer Mott I. William. Bred by Courtlandt Farm(KY).

INDESCRIBABLE unhurried for a half three wide, moved up in that path on the second turn, angled to the outside once in the stretch and closed fast to be up in the final strides. LONG APPROACH forwardly placed off the inside, moved out three wide on the second turn, was patiently ridden into the stretch, responded to urging in the final furlong, wore down KISS WITH A TWIST late but missed. KISS WITH A TWIST forwardly placed three wide, challenged on the second turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and held on gamely. CALLWOOD DANCER (IRE) set the pace near the rail, battled into the final furlong and weakened. SOUSAPHONE close up along the inside while in hand, angled out for the drive but lacked a bid. LADY DIGBY reserved three wide, made a mild middle move in that path but could not sustain the bid. MERIBEL within striking distance along the inside, moved out to the three path for the second turn, held on well to the stretch and tired. CIAO forwardly placed three wide, moved in a bit on the backstretch, stayed on well to the final furlong and tired. BALLYMORE LADY within striking distance of the rail, moved to the inside on the second turn and gave way in the drive. QUEENDOM was outrun.
