4- READY FOR RYE

by PROMISE AND HOPE in the process of stumbling, tucked along the rail before reaching the end of the backstretch, left it at the five-sixteenths marker, fanned out into the six path travelling through the furlong grounds, made no impact. ASK CHUCK broke towards the inside, took up the chase in the two path on the bend, swung into the fifth one coming to the five-sixteenths pole, failed to menace. PROMISE AND HOPE bumped from both sides at the start, bobbled and got steadied afterwards, raced along the outside and was outrun. OLD MEXICO along the inside route chasing a disputed pace, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, faltered. ARTEMUSMAILCARRIER hustled over to the rail after being bumped at the start, failed to reach a contending position. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run

CARPÉ DIEM got off to a clean start, one of only three to do so as the field was sent on its way, grabbed the early advantage, argued to protect it with LOUISIANA BROWN glued to his outside, had that rival crank up the pressure approaching the quarter pole, fully roused by this stage, got roused himself, left the three-sixteenths pole with READY FOR RYE having joined the fracas, began the final furlong locked in a one on one fight with the last-named opponent, came out slightly deep into the furlong grounds, staved that rival off and kicked away to a comfortable lead, with the runner up not asked for his best in the final stages. READY FOR RYE was knocked into RIVER OF DREAMS after making contact with ARTEMUSMALCARRIER at the start, appeared to get clipped from behind right afterwards, recovered with good courage and left the backstretch in a forward position, chased the pair of fighting front runners from the three path around the bend, entered the stretch within range of them, drew abreast, began to lug in, gradually but steadily between the three-sixteenths pole and the furlong marker, putting the squeeze on LOUISIANA BROWN, with the top one collaborating on a minor scale himself belatedly, fought with vigor to try and attain the lead, got staved off, finished the final seventy yards geared down. LOUISIANA BROWN angled inward after coming out of the gate in good order, sparred in the two path with the eventual winner, spun into the stretch on nearly even terms and having been set down to a full drive, had the runner up join the pace fight soon afterwards, got squeezed back and steadied by the first two finishers, altered course to the outside and finished willingly to secure the show. WHATEVERYOUWANT shied inward and away from ASK CHUCK, wound up making contact with its next door neighbor on the other side, raced two wide on the turn, displaying an inclination to get out, pilot counteracting it with a strong grip on the left side and some light taps on the opposite side near the area of the shoulder, swung four wide into the stretch, proved no match. RIVER OF DREAMS bumped with READY ON RYE right after the start, stumbled while seeming to clip that foe's heels right afterwards, got bumped
