CASA CREED got set in the pocket after the field had been sent on its way, was rated keeping watch on the front runners for the first half, inched his way to the outside approaching the end of the bend, got set down angling to the outside stepping onto the turn, straightened away then bid five wide with success, to begin the final furlong narrowly in front, continued to do battle with the runner up and would not be denied. SOCIAL PARANOIA off the inside throughout, crept up three wide after being let a notch early on the turn, was cued up challenging four wide into upper stretch, saw the winner narrowly in front at the eighth pole, dueled with that foe with willingness thereafter but had to settle for the place. ALL AMERICAN HERO vied for command to the outside of BRITTAS BAY, chipped away at the deficit after the first fraction had been finalized, was between rivals once the second place finisher burst upon the scene beyond the three-eighths pole, was put to a drive for the drive home, led the others into the lane by the barest of margins, got overhauled soon afterwards, backed away readily in the last eighth. SPIRIT ANIMAL steadied after shying in momentarily after springing from the gate, climbed for a spell on the chute before settling into stride, got guided over to the inside route, took it until the general area of the five-sixteenths marker, was maneuvered into path six from upper to midstretch, made no impact. BRITTAS BAY put to a mild hand ride right after the start, motored to the top, was soon joined by ALL AMERICAN HERO, showed the way being pressed by that foe, felt an increase in pressure after the half had been completed, yielded under a drive coming up the quarter pole, hung out prominently for a little while longer then retreated. BRONXVILLE stalked the front runners in range three wide, was asked for more in addition to having the pilot flash the whip from the right by the five-sixteenths pole, didn't pick it up. BUMPERDOO in path two stepping onto the turn, was never involved. BRIDGETOTHEFUTURE quickly spotted along the rail, offered no response after being switched over to some encouragement in the general area of the five-sixteenths marker. GOLDEN BREW pursued the front runners two to three wide on the turn, failed to make his presence felt.
