DANCE IN THE MOOD (JPN) settled outside a rival, advanced three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch, drifted in but pulled clear under a left handed tap of the whip and steady handling. SWEET TALKER between rivals early, stalked outside a foe, came three deep into the stretch and split horses late to gain the place. LUAS LINE (IRE) three wide early, stalked the pace outside a rival then off the rail, also came out into the stretch and got up for the show four wide on the line. DANCING EDIE steadied off heels nearing the first turn, pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, went between horses into the stretch and split rivals at the wire. CAMBIOCORSA pulled early, stalked a bit off the rail then bid outside the pacesetter, took the lead leaving the second turn, fought back toward the inside in the stretch, could not match the winner but gave ground grudgingly to the others. SHINING ENERGY unhurried inside early, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. TOUPIE (GB) saved ground chasing the pace and did not rally. FLYING GLITTER pulled her way to the early lead and angled inside, set the pace along the rail, dueled on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch.
