Bay Colt, (Mar), by Harlan's Holiday - Leslie's Lady by Tricky Creek. Trainer Mandella E. Richard. Bred by James T. Hines Jr.(KY). INTO MISCHIEF angled in and dueled outside a rival or between horses, took a short lead in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch and held on gamely under urging. COLONEL JOHN bumped at the start, pulled his way along off the rail then inside chasing the pace, split rivals in deep stretch and gained the place. MASSIVE DRAMA close up stalking the pace inside, came out for room into the stretch and held third. MONBA three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out in the stretch and found his best stride late. INDIAN SUN settled inside chasing the pace, came out bit in the stretch and had a mild late bid. SIERRA SUNSET pulled early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, split horses leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. EATON'S GIFT had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MEAL PENALTY pulled his way along four wide into the first turn, bid three deep on the backstretch, stalked again on the second turn and weakened. OVEREXTENDED unhurried inside then outside a rival, angled in again on the second turn and did not rally. SHORE DO squeezed back at the start, settled between horses then inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. REFEREE wide early, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. TRES BORRACHOS broke out a bit, chased outside or alongside a rival and also weakened.
