CASINO DRIVE stalked under a hold a bit off the rail then outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, was pushed along to inch away in midstretch then held under some late urging. DAKOTA PHONE close up stalking the pace inside, came off the rail leaving the second turn, swung out into the stretch and finished willingly. SENSATIONAL SCORE chased between horses, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. INFORMED had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then between foes on the second turn and into the stretch and was outfinished. BY SPOT (BRZ) dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the drive and weakened in the final furlong. GREGORIAN BAY stalked inside, went between horses leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, angled in again leaving that turn and lacked the needed response. ASPERITY broke out a bit, was four wide early then chased three deep, went four wide into the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response.
