SONGBIRD off a half length the fastest, maintained the advantage, was towards the two path entering the clubhouse turn, cut the splits,

rated and being shadowed by CARINA MIA parked to her outside, had nearly wandered into the three path by the conclusion of the backstretch, cut over sharply to the inside route past the half mile pole, with the runner up likewise shifting inward and whittling away at the defict, had that opponent well attached as three-quarters was being reached, continued to see the lead dwindle down, was the first to have its pilot commit to urgent encouragement, this occurring a few jumps shy of the quarter pole, spun into the lane clutching the lead by approximately a neck,

repulsed a strong challenge by CARINA MIA, began to edge away during the run leading up and through the furlong grounds, lenghtened away in the final furlong, kept to the task at hand until the last few strides. CARINA MIA away in good order, secured a prominent position, was patiently handled stalking the winner to her outside during the journey to the half mile pole, picked up interest departing the backstretch, narrowed in on the top one, was a long head short of being in front as the top twosome came into the stretch, settled into upper and had the rider go to work, issued a stiff bid but failed to go by, steadilly lost ground on the winner in the last eighth, yet earned a second best designation. FLORA DORA saved ground early, got angled into the three path approaching the three-eighths pole, proved no match. MO D'AMOUR bobbled inward springing from the gate, brushed with WEEP NO MORE, worked out a tuck in the two path by the crown of the first turn, continued from off the inside, entererd the stretcvh and had no response. WEEP NO MORE made light contact with MO D'AMOUR at the start, was sluggish in the early going, got sent to the

rail before arriving at the end of the homestretch, chased the front runners two to three wide on the far turn, had already been put a drive by the five-sixteenths marker, made no headway.
