ABEL TASMAN came away in good order, swung three wide into the clubhouse turn, was kept in hand making her way around it, tipped out in the direction of path five stepping into the backstretch, unleashed a bold middle move to draw up to the leader, shifted back into the three path before arriving at the half mile pole, sat poised well to the outside of SUMMER LUCK, as the twosome raced on nearly terms to the end of the second bend, got cued up spinning into the stretch having taken over, got pounced upon by a revved-up ELATE, went at it head to head with that rival for the ensuing furlong, began to gradually shift towards the nemesis during stretch from midlane to the sixteenth pole, nudged ELATE into tight quarters in the final seventy yards, went shoulder to shoulder with her afterwards and gamely reached the finish first. ELATE settled for the pocket trip after being beaten to the lead by SUMMER LUCK, was patiently ridden keeping watch on the front runners, picked up interest angling into an available two path during the opening stages of the run around the far turn, cut into the deficit to loom a threat by the quarter pole, got set down racing for the top of the lane, edged up to confront ABLE TASMAN, fought fiercely but couldn't get by, got induced by the inward-shifting winner towards the rail in deep stretch, saw the pair leaning heavily on each other in the final stages and although determined to the end, had to settle for a second best designation. SALTY broke the tardiest after leaping into the left side of the starting gate, was approximately two wide entering the first turn and three wide exiting it, stepped off the backstretch, steadily moved wider and after a couple of foes got maneuvered to the outside themselves, left the five-sixteenths pole hung out in the five path, swung to the outside entering the stretch, began the final furlong in the vicinity of the eight path, mustered up good courage to secure the show. BERNED two wide during the initial stages, worked her way into the path three early on the far turn, was asked to pick it up at the five-sixteenths pole, failed to do so. DADDYS LIL DARLING got sent three wide off the first turn, continued at a considerable distance from off the inside, was guided into the four path leaving the midway point on the far turn, had no rally. SUMMER LUCK grabbed the advantage and cut over to the inside early on the first turn, showed the way being shadowed by the eventual winner a couple of paths to her outside, beginning from midway on the backstretch, succumbed when put to the test by that opponent after arriving at the quarter pole and faltered. CORPORATE QUEEN took the inside route on the first turn, ventured out into path two path on the backstretch but was back down on the rail by the half mile pole, angled two wide for the drive home and had no offering. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run, in addition to a claim of foul lodged by the rider of ELATE against the rider of ABEL TASMAN alleging interference, the result was allowed to stand and the race was declared official.
