With \$125,000 guaranteed, of which \$68,750 to first, \$25,000 to second, \$12,500 to third, \$6,250 to fourth, and \$1,250 to all other finishers. Three Year Olds, 121 lbs; Older, 124. Fillies and Mares Allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of three races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$40,000 or greater since January 1, 2011, allowed 2 lbs.; of two races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$32,000 or greater since January 1, 2011, allowed 4 lbs.; of a race for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$32,000 or greater since January 1, 2011, allowed 6 lbs. Maximum of 14 starters. Trainer Nominations closed Friday, August 31, 2012. Regular Nominations closed Friday, November 9, 2012 with 40 Nominations. NIKKI'S SANDCASTLE stalked the pace, moved up three wide through the far turn and finished gamely to just get up in a determined run. MAJOR MARVEL pressed the pace from the inside, dug in nearing the sixteenth pole and just missed in a game effort. EXCLUSIVE STRIKE stalked the pace, angled to the inside soon after the start, moved up through the far turn while continuing to race along the inside, swung out four wide in the lane and finished willingly to the wire. KING DAVID was slow early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and showed good late interest. DIAMONSDIPLOMAT showed good early speed from the outside and faltered in the final stages. EL ROMANO dropped back early, raced five deep in the lane and had no final winning bid. BINGO BANGO BONGO settled off the early pace, saved ground and never was a factor. TOM KITTEN raced in a bit tight at the start, raced three deep and never menaced. THE BEST GLACIER showed little. KING KREEA clipped heels at the start and remained back throughout. KATRINA'S PRINCE failed to menace. LIVINGSTON STREET failed to sustain a bid.
