BROTHER BIRD stalked the pace from the outside while racing three deep, dug in deep stretch and got up in his final strides under strong encouragement. JAZZIT showed good speed while racing along the inside and gave way grudgingly in the final stages to be second best. FOLLOW THE LEADER stalked the pace, saved ground throughout and finished willingly to the wire. SAINTLY LOVE was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and made a good late gain. AWESOME MICH stalked the leaders from the outside, raced five wide into the upper stretch and had no final winning bid. HE'S SPECTACULAR dropped back early, saved ground and had no response. VICTORY NOTION was slow early, swung out seven wide in the stretch and never was a serious threat. RED HILLS clipped heels soon after the start, raced four deep and never was a factor. TRITONK pressed the pace and gave way. CUNAGUARO was unhurried early and remained back throughout. ONLY BOY showed little. COMMANDER TATE raced back throughout and was eased late.
