FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE STARTED FOR A CLAIMING PRICE OF \$35,000 OR LESS SINCE AUGUST 1, 2006. 500 to start or by supplemental fee of 5% of the guaranteed purse by July 20, 2007. \$150,000 Guaranteed. Monies to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 1% to all other finishers. Weight: Three-Year-Olds, 117 lbs. Ol der, 124 lbs. Fillies and Mares allowed 5 lbs. additional. Non-winners of three races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$50,000 or greater since August 1, 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; of two races for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$40,000 or greater since August 1, 2006, allowed 4 lbs.; of a race for an allowance purse or for a starter or claiming price of \$40,000 or greater since August 1, 2006, allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 starters. If this race overfills preference will be given in accordance with the field selection point system outlined by the "Claiming Crown Summary of Conditions". (Hazy 98)

MIAMI SUNRISE close up near the inside, angled out for the drive, caught the leader with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. SEMI LOST set the pace near the rail, repulsed RICARDO after a half, withstood a challenge by DEMAGOGUERY on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch, responded when challenged by the winner and held on gamely to be second best. KINGS CHALLENGE within striking distance off the inside, improved his position while no threat. DEMAGOGUERY prominent from the start three wide, made a solid run at the leader on the second turn but tired in the drive. CHIN HIGH outrun along the inside, rallied belatedly. ANDIAMO within striking distance five wide, moved in a path on the second turn and tired. SOUPY outrun to the stretch, made a bid too late. JAMIAN was no threat. RICARDO A hopped a bit at the start, rushed to press the pace, held on well for six furlongs and gave way. MINING FOR SILVER could not menace.
