MONUMENT between horses early, prompted the pace outside a rival, took the lead into the stretch, inched away under left handed urging in midstretch, ducked in from the right handed whip a sixteenth out but won clear. BALLARD RULER bobbed at the start, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, continued inside into and on the second turn, split horses in deep stretch and gained the place. STAR ROCKER also bobbed at the start, angled in and stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, could not catch the winner and was edged for the place. LOVMEISTER pulled three deep nearing the first turn, stalked outside a rival, was between horses midway on the second turn, angled in some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. O WILD WEST WIND angled in and pulled his way along inside chasing the pace, continued along the rail on the second turn and improved position in the stretch. REAL HEAT chased three wide or outside a rival, went three deep again on the second turn and did not rally. THE HUMANCOMPLAINT between foes early, chased inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn and outside a rival into the stretch and lacked a response in the drive. WARREN'S ROCKY bumped at the start, settled inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. STRONG WIND broke in and bumped a rival, had speed inside and dueled for the lead, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch, then weakened. LIFE A RILEY pulled his way along and drifted out some into the first turn, settled outside a rival or off the rail and had nothing left for the stretch.
