WILLA B AWESOME stalked off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the backstretch, took the lead on the second turn, inched away into the stretch, fought back inside the winner in midstretch and until deep stretch, could not match that one late but was clearly second best. RAESUNBRIDLEDFAITH stumbled at the start, settled off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. ONE MAGICAL GIRL sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. REAL DREAM saved ground off the pace, went outside a rival leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TOLUCA pulled hard and lugged out some and steadied into the first turn, angled in on that bend, steadied again into the backstretch, stalked along the rail, fell back some on the second turn and gave way in the stretch.
