1 MILE. (1.33²) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 IROQUOIS S.(GRADE III) FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each on or before October 10, 2007 or by supplementary nomination of \$7,500 each at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes, 4 lbs.; two races other than claiming, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday , October 10, 2007 with 46 nominations. (Clear 61)

COURT VISION settled two wide in hand early, was patiently ridden, fanned six or seven wide for the final furlong, then closed determinedly under urging to wear down HALO NAJIB in the late going. HALO NAJIB, bumped at the start by MYTHICAL PEGASUS when that one was forced out by SOK SOK, was never far back while tracking the leaders four or five wide, reached the front between calls in deep stretch, then failed to contain the winner's surge. ST. JOE gained the lead early and briefly was clear, allowed CHITTOZ to take over from the rail midway on the backstretch, raced just off that one to the stretch, regained a narrow advantage, then grudgingly weakened late in a good effort. SOK SOK drifted out at the start bumping MYTHICAL PEGASUS, forced that one out on HALO NAJIB, gained a forward position between horses three or four wide, maneuvered four or five wide for the final furlong to make a run but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. CHITTOZ, up close inside early, took over midway on the backstretch, briefly was clear, managed a narrow lead while battling inside of ST. JOE to the stretch and weakened. LITTLE NICK, within striking distance and three wide, made a mild run between leaving the turn but couldn't continue. PULASKI RUNNER was outrun. MYTHICAL PEGASUS, bumped at the break by SOK SOK and forced out on HALO NAJIB, was well placed between horses three or four wide for nearly six furlongs and weakened. BEN AND THE TWIN raced forwardly near the inside for five furlongs and weakened soon after.
