7 FURLONGS. (1:20²) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 Churchill Downs S. Presented by Twinspires.com FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$15,000 each at the time of entry. \$2,500 to pass the entry box; \$2,500 additional to start, with \$500,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes since October 30, allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade I or II stakes since September 5, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Churchill Downs will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest 2016-2017 earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations are required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Saturday, April 15, 2017 with 33 nominations. (Clear 60)

Dark Bay or Brown Gelding, (Apr), by Successful Appeal - Gift of Gab by In Excess (IRE). Trainer Ben Colebrook. Bred by Mike Ball & Katherine Ball (KY).

LIMOUSINE LIBERAL sat perched three wide off of a hotly contested pace, took closer order after a half mile, forged to command entering the lane, kicked clear under a drive, wandered outward in deep stretch and was fully extended to prevail. AWESOME SLEW settled off the early pace while saving ground, gained just off the inside in upper stretch, worked between foes leaving the three sixteenths, altered in sharply for room near the eighth pole, split rivals, continued on gamely inside the winner and just missed. TOM'S READY, in mid pack off the inside, progressed four wide into the lane, shifted out wider soon after, closed steadily and drifted a bit very late. SOLID WAGER rated off the early pace, came four wide for the drive, moved out wider advancing near mid stretch, failed to switch leads, lost a bit of momentum as he came in slightly to race in close proximity of TOM'S READY then closed the gap. THE TRUTH OR ELSE, bumped at the break, settled well back, picked up some steam leaving the five sixteenths, swung very wide and kept on with interest. CLEARLY NOW, bumped at the break, rated off the early pace, checked off heels with run entering the lane, regrouped to work between rivals through the final furlong and continued willingly. DENMAN'S CALL, urged along off the inside, quickly gained leaving the five sixteenths, brushed with BLUEGRASS SINGER in mid stretch and flattened out. SCHIVARELLI, in tight at the break, was unhurried early saving ground, altered out near mid stretch, shifted back in but failed to make a strong impact. CHIEF OF STAFF, bumped at the break, chased the leaders four wide, moved up a bit in upper stretch then faded. APPREHENDER saved ground early, angled four to five wide and lacked a solid run. EL KABEIR, urged along off the rail, came six wide for the drive and gave way. BLUEGRASS SINGER had speed to lead early, was headed from his inside leaving the five eighths, pressed MASOCHISTIC around the turn, was between foes nearing the lane, kept on past the three sixteenths, brushed with a rival in mid stretch and gave way. MASOCHISTIC rushed up inside and moved to a slim lead after a quarter mile, was hounded around the turn, ceded command past the quarter pole, stayed on to about mid stretch then surrendered. FOREVAMO came in at the break and bumped with CLEARLY NOW, corrected and moved up towards the inside to chase, gained a bit near the three sixteenths, failed to kick on, was checked sharply as AWESOME SLEW angled in near the eighth pole and gave way. An objection by the rider of SOLID WAGER against TOM'S READY for alleged interference in deep stretch was not allowed.
