RARE CANDY between horses early, angled in and chased inside, split rivals in midstretch, came out and was edged for the show. HOT ORE angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and was outfinished. CANADA also angled in and chased inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
