ANALYZE IT had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away leaving the second turn and drew clear under a vigorous hand ride, some late taps of the whip and a long hold in the final strides. PUBILIUS SYRUS pulled between foes and steadied early, chased three deep then outside a rival, went three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the place. EAST RAND steadied when squeezed just after the start, angled in on the first turn and settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and edged rivals for the show. CHOO CHOO pulled and steadied early and again into the first turn, settled inside, came out in the stretch and was edged for third four wide on the line. INSCOM pulled his way along to stalk the pace three deep, steadied midway on the backstretch, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and was edged for a minor award between foes. EXTRORDINARY JERRY stalked three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAGIC MUSKETIER steadied in tight when pulling into the first turn, saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside in the stretch then split foes late. GOLDEN DRAGON saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BIG BUZZ pulled early then angled in and chased between horses and did not rally. ARMOUR PLATE in tight early, pulled between foes and steadied into the first turn, stalked inside on the backstretch and second turn and weakened. KING EDDIE had good early speed and dueled outside the winner, stalked leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
