GREENPOINTCRUSADER was bumped from both sides after stumbling from the starting gate, raced from off the inside, got let out approaching the end of the backstretch, gradually worked his way further and further off the inside during the run around the bend, continued to be maneuvered to the outside after stepping foot into the stretch, began the final furlong about seven wide, closed in, wrested away the advantage with a sixteenth to go and kicked away to win by a comfortable margin. SUNNY RIDGE broke well and secured a prominent position, pressed the issue from the three path as the widest of a trio, spluttered four wide into the stretch on the verge of snatching away the lead, did do so shortly afterwards, offered resistance before relinquishing to the winner at approximately the sixteenth marker, continued onward willingly enough to procure the place. PORTFOLIO MANAGER pursued the ongoing pace dispute from the four path, fanned out a couple of more ones heading for the three-sixteenths pole, mustered up a mild kick for the show award, although no match for the top twosome. SAIL AHOY unhurried during the initial stages while racing along the outside, angled into the three path after making it onto the turn, was put to solid encouragement past the three-eighths pole, commenced the stretch slighter wider, came up empty. TALE OF S'AVALL gained a slight advantage after the start, was pulling on the bit while being guided over to the inside, cut the pace, kept at a slight distance from off the rail, and facing pressure from two others, parked out in paths two and three respectively, came under assault from the second place finisher as three-quarters was being reached, yielded soon afterwards and steadily backed away. RALIS settled into the two path after the start, jostled with MAGNA LIGHT in the early going, still sat entrenched in the two path after a series of bumps with the previously-named foe, contended for the lead from between rivals for six furlongs and gave way. MAGNA LIGHT stayed along the inside after leaving the gate, appeared to be a bit keen in the early going, brushed into the FALIS as a prelude to try and abandon the inside route, got hooked up a jousting match consisting of a multi-numbered of bumps with the aforementioned rival right afterwards, was forced to slither back onto the inside route after that foe stubbornly held his ground, travelled on the turn having been put to a full drive, faded once into the lane. READY DANCER bumped at the start, raced four to three wide on the turn, was never involved.
