ICON IKE was settled in the early going, rallied and moved out to be five wide in upper stretch, was closing fast on the outside and was up in the final jump to set a new track record. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE was settled then rallied on the turn while three wide, moved out to be four wide for the stretch drive and was charging to the wire like a freight train but was caught in the final jump. CANULETMEDOWNEASY dueled for the early lead while inside setting fast fractions, drew off in upper stretch but tired in late stretch. QUE POSSE was unhurried early then rallied on the turn, was three wide in the stretch and split rivals in late stretch to finish well. FLAT BLACK dueled for the lead while two wide, was hard used then weakened in the stretch. RICH JEWEL was inside and saving ground on the turn making a bid but came up empty in late stretch. SOULTOWN was settled then allied three wide in upper stretch, angled inside in and was blocked behind rivals in mid stretch and hung. STORM'S PROMISE chased the early pace while two wide, was used up and faltered. KONKIGO was inside and saving ground on the turn then made a bid to mid stretch but came up empty in the end. ANTIOCH DIAMOND raced three wide into the turn, was used up then gave way.
