sixteenth of a mile, pulled his way clear and was angled in leaving the far turn, set a solid pace under rating, met outside pressure nearing the lane, battled inside the winner past the eighth pole and kept on gamely to be well clear of the rest. GIMME DA LUTE broke a step slow then brushed with

HEBBRONVILLE, was hustled up between rivals soon after, steadied when in close near the half mile pole, recovered and circled four wide under a strong ride, straightened away for the drive and continued with interest to earn the show. BLAME JIM was hustled up inside foes soon

after the break, came off the inside past the five eighths, steadied reacting to CITY OF VENGEANCE near the half mile pole, regrouped to make a run between rivals mid turn, shifted out some nearing the eighth pole and kept on willingly. HEBBRONVILLE, brushed at the break, was taken to rate while saving ground off the pace, angled out under a ride near the quarter pole but failed to muster up a solid rally.
