1 MILE. (1.33<sup>2</sup>) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *CHILUKKI S.(GRADE II)* FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each on or before October 21, 2006 or by supplementary nomination of \$7,500 each at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three year olds 122 lbs., Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I at a mile or over in 2006, 2 lbs.; a Grade II at a mile or over in 2006, 4 lbs.; \$60,000 twice in 2006, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Close Saturday, October 21, 2006 with 30 nominations. (Clear 43)

Bay Filly, (Apr), by Mr. Greeley - Alvear by Seattle Slew. Trainer Matz R. Michael. Bred by Dorothy A. Matz(KY).

SANGRITA maneuvered in early to force the pace three or four wide, took over from pacesetter MAY DELANEY approaching the stretch, put down an inside challenge from INDIAN FLARE in the upper stretch and drove clear. JOINT EFFORT, well placed three or four wide from early on, worked her way out five wide for the drive, bumped for a stride with LADY PEGASUS at the three-sixteenths pole, then couldn't close on the winner late as second best. INDIAN FLARE, well placed from early on and inside, made a bold run from the rail entering the upper stretch, was on even terms for the lead but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. WILD FIT bumped the gate while breaking sluggishly, raced near the inside, eased out three wide for the drive and couldn't offer a serious late threat. LADY PEGASUS, never far back while in behind horses four wide, moved out six wide for the drive, was bumped by JOINT EFFORT about the three-sixteenths pole and failed to muster a late response. TRIPPI STREET maneuvered in early to track the pace four or five wide, raced forwardly into the final furlong and flattened out. HUMOROUS GAL drifted in at the start, raced near the inside early, moved four wide on the turn, came out eight wide for the stretch run and lacked a serious late bid. MARY DELANEY gained the lead early, raced in the three path, lost the edge to the winner nearing the stretch and weakened thereafter. GOLDEN LOCKET was outrun.
