1 MILE. (1.33²) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 *CHILUKKI S. (GRADE II) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD.* By subscription of \$150 each or by supplementary nomination of \$7,500 each at time of entry. \$750 to pass the entry box; \$750 additional to start, with \$150,000 added. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Three year olds, 122 lbs., Older 125 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I at a mile or over in 2012 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II at a mile or over in 2012, 4 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Chilukki will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then highest earnings in 2012. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, October 17, 2012 with 21 nominations. (Showery 41)

BRUSHED BY A STAR behind the leaders three wide, angled out for the drive, challenged in midstretch and proved best under pressure. JOYFUL VICTORY prompted the pace outside, raced five wide on the turn, challenged with three furlongs to go, gained a short lead in midstretch but was outfinished. SALTY STRIKE pressed the pace four wide, held on well to midstretch and tired. JUANITA forced the pace three wide, challenged once in the turn, gained a short lead approaching the stretch but tired in the final furlong. INDULGENCE outrun early, raced three wide on the turn, angled out for the drive but lacked a rally. SPECTACULAR SKY set the pace off the inside, moved to the rail in the stretch and tired. BONNIE'S EMPIRE carried out at the start, was outrun four wide and never threatened. MAKE A TOAST drifted cut at the start, raced in the five path on the turn and was no factor. DANCINGINHERDREAMS had speed for a half near the inside. BRILLIANT FUTURE outrun early, raced in the seven path on the turn and never reached contention.
