BEAU RECALL (IRE) was unhurried, tucked in along the hedge, came under a ride on the far turn, swung five wide into the lane, quickened once straightened, swamped GOT STORMY inside the furlong marker and shook clear. GOT STORMY settled in hand, advanced between rivals through the second turn, came four wide and struck the front leaving the three-sixteenths pole, opened clear and was kept to task, was unable to go on with the winner and was just able to preserve the runner up spot. DADDY IS A LEGEND settled off the shrub, worked her way forward between runners, shifted out and loomed a danger entering the stretch, churned on but was out kicked. ENVIRONS (GB) came away a step slow, was unhurried three deep, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly between horses. PRECIEUSE (IRE) was allowed to settle, ranged up three wide on the second turn, offered a mild bid five wide entering the lane, but failed to sustain the drive. PROCTOR'S LEDGE settled saving ground, got through every step into the lane, lacked room a furlong out, altered out a bit but toiled fruitlessly thereafter. CAPLA TEMPTRESS (IRE) attended the pace along the inside, assumed command before going a half, contested the pace to the stretch and tired. VALEDICTORIAN was close up three wide, moved with CAPLA TEMPTRESS (IRE) to jointly vie for the lead, disputed the tempo to the lane and wilted. RAVEN'S LADY (GB) pulled and was hard to settle into the first turn, leveled into stride along the hedge on the backstretch, but lacked a response when called upon. TAKE THESE CHAINS (IRE) was away alertly, set a clear pace off of the inside, drifted well out on the backstretch, was in contention to the second turn and stopped.
