DAAHER was bumped at the start, quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, took a clear lead into the stretch, dug in gamely when roused and remained clear to the finish. MIDNIGHT LUTE came away in good order, was steered to the outside on the backstretch, raced close up while under stout restraint, ranged up three wide approaching the stretch, but could make little impact when sent after the winner in upper stretch and stayed on to best the others. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER was bumped at the start, was outrun early, raced inside and lacked a rally. XCHANGER chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. SIR GREELEY raced close up along the inside, came wide into the stretch and had no response when roused.
