

1 MILE. (1:32²) STAKES. Purse \$670,000 Cigar Mile H.A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$5,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. NYRA to offer a guaranteed purse of \$500,000. If any Breeders' Cup winner were to start in the Cigar Mile the purse for that horse would increase to \$1,000,000. If any Grade One winner were to start in the Cigar Mile the purse for that horse would increase to \$750,000. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5 to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. TONALIST settled into the two path soon after the break, had the rider resort to some hand urging to keep pace on the turn yet fell back slightly nonetheless, angled three wide into the lane, made up a minimal amount of ground during the ensuing furlong, altered course a couple of paths wider with under a sixteenth remaining, kicked into his best stride after attaining the desired optimal racing clearance, gamely outfinished three determined rivals in the last few jumps to earn the decision. RED VINE got guided over to the rail shortly after the start, sat forwardly placed, was lightly hand urging, idling behind PRIVATE ZONE during the last stages of the run around the bend, set foot into the lane, but remained mired in traffic, had the rider steady prior to altering course a couple of paths towards the middle of strip in midlane, was given his cue and instantly picked up speed, split rivals in deep stretch, closed in with good determination, but fell short. MATROOH stalked the pacesetter from the three path for six furlongs, issued a bid for command as the field neaded into the stretch, arrived at the eighth pole as the new leader, but just barely, dug in stubbornly but ultimately had to settle for the show award. MSHAWISH chased a keen PRIVATE ZONE from about the same path as that one took for nearly six furlongs, angled out four wide into the stretch, fought his way towards the lead, began the final furlong almost having secured it, battled hard before weakening in the last forty yards. PRIVATE ZONE lost his footing being released from the starting gate, yet still broke with the lead, appeared headstrong right from the get-go, fighting with noticeable force on the bit, cut the pace from the two path, rider high up in the irons, came under assault approaching the quarter pole, drifted over closer to the rail for the beginning of the stretch drive, held out on the front end until deep into the furlong grounds, steadily weakened thereafter. FULL OF MINE chased the pace from the two path, was asked to pick up interest moving outward from the five-sixteenths marker, wound up five wide by the conclusion of the move, lacked the needed response.
