VYJACK angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to get up three wide late. OM chased inside then a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch, bid between horses in deep stretch and went gamely to the line. OBVIOUSLY (IRE) dueled three deep on the first turn then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside and held on gamely but was outfinished late. PERFECTLY MAJESTIC angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and improved position. HOOTENANNY settled a bit off the rail, chased outside a rival on the second turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PATRIOTS RULE unhurried along the inside for six furlongs, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. EXPRESS HIMSELF (IRE) hesitated to be away behind the field, settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival, continued inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. ST. JOE BAY dueled between horses on the first turn then stalked outside a rival, found the rail into the stretch and weakened. ED JOHNSON settled outside a rival then off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. FRANK CONVERSATION had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked along the rail on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
