1st MILES. (1.47¹) STAKES. Purse \$500,000 *CLARK H. (GRADE I) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD*. By subscription of \$300 each or by supplementary nomination of \$15,000 each by 12:00 noon (EST) Thursday, November 20, 2014. \$2,500 to pass the entry box; \$2,500 additional to start, with \$500,000 added. After payment of 1 % to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Friday, November 21, 2014. The maximum number of starters for the Clark Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights, with consideration to the scale of weights for age. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, November 12, 2014 with 20 nominations. (Cloudy 37)

HOPPERTUNITY tracked the pace early in the five path, swung into the six path entering the lane while kicking on, took over command and dug in gamely in the final stages. PROTONICO was well placed early, fanned into the five path in the far turn, rallied into the stretch, made a late bid but did not have enough in the final stages. CONSTITUTION set the pace early from the four path, fanned into the five path entering the lane and yielded late in the stretch run from the inside. PICK OF THE LITTER was unhurried early, on the inside into the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. EASTER GIFT broke awkwardly at the start and was back early, swung into the six path in the far turn while making a bid but was empty late in the stretch. PRAYER FOR RELIEF was never a threat. DEPARTING chased the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and faded in the stretch. LOOKING COOL was through after a half. KNIGHTS NATION was done early.
