**1 1/8 MILE. (1:47<sup>1</sup>) STAKES.** Purse \$500,000 Clark H.FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$300 each or by supplementary nomination of \$15,000 each by 12:00 noon (EST) Thursday, November 19, 2015. \$2,500 to pass the entry box; \$2,500 additional to start, with \$500,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Friday, November 20, 2015. The maximum number of starters for the Clark Handicap will be limited to fourteen (14). If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to highweights, with consideration to the scale of weights for age. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. All supplementary nominations will be required to pay entry and starting fees if they participate. Trophy to winning owner. Closed Wednesday, November 11, 2015 with 23 nominations. (Cloudy 67)

**Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Apr), by Mineshaft - What a Pear by E Dubai. Trainer James A. Jerkens. Bred by Dr. Russell S. Cohen (NY).**

EFFINEX was well placed early, swung into the six path entering the lane while making a bid, took over command in the stretch under a long drive, inched clear in the final stages while drifting out late in the lane. HOPPERTUNITY was unhurried early along the seven path, stayed in the seven path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch, made a bid five wide in the stretch under a long drive but did not have enough late. LOOKS TO SPARE lunged at the start and was back early, shifted into the four path in the far turn, angled more to the inside in the stretch, made a bid late but hung in the final stages. KEEN ICE trailed the field early from the inside, shifted into the three path in the far turn, was rolling late in the stretch but was too late and just missed show in the final stages. RACE DAY stalked the pace early along the six path, took over command inside the five sixteenth pole, stayed outside in the five path entering the lane, was put under a long drive in the stretch under pressure from both sides and gave in late. PROTONICO tracked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch run. SHOTGUN KOWBOY pressed the pace early from the five path, shifted into the three path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch drive. MR. Z set the pace early for a half, angled off the rail into the far turn and gave way in the stretch.
